MBCM Cell Phone Policy:

We understand the necessity for girls to have a phone (especially those from out of town) to arrange carpools and other afterschool activities as well as to keep in touch with family. In order to respect the important work of the classroom and the teaching and learning environment, this document is to clarify the cell phone policy for the school. The policy is:

Cell phones are to be turned off and turned into the office upon arrival at school. Students will have a personalized pocket hanging by the office in which to place their phone. The phone will remain there until dismissal.
Cell phone may be picked up at the end of the school day. If a cell phone was left at home, the office will call the parent to verify this. If a student is found to be in school with a cell phone it will be confiscated.
The phone will be held in the office until Friday of that week.
There will be random phone verification where the student will be asked to turn on their phone and call the office.

The staff of MBCM ask for your FULL co-operation with our policy. Please do not tell your daughter that you will call or message her during the day as that will encourage her to keep her phone with her.
